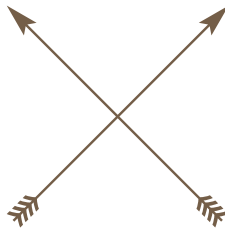
Featured Guest Brewery:

Estate Seven Hills Vineyard, Walla Walla Valley, Washington *pretty aromas of spiced wild berries, including cassis and boysenberry, along with tobacco, pencil lead and licorice that are lifted by floral notes of spring flowers and provocal herbs, the finish is complex and silky*
