

## Wines by the Glass

### **Pinot Grigio, Scarpetta 2018**

Northern Italy **\$10**

light and dry with veins of minerality and floral aromatics. this wine is crisp and dry with medium high acidity and tastes of stone fruits, lavender, honey, pear, white flowers and minerals.

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Stratum 2018**

Waipara Valley, New Zealand **\$12**

displays abundant aromas of gooseberries and tropical fruits on the nose. the palate is fresh and lively showing rich concentration and a long lingering finish.

### **Vinho Verde, Arca Nova Loureiro 2019**

Portugal **\$10**

Intense and fruity, tropical aromas of banana and mango. Distinct floral aromas blended in harmony with the abundant fruit.

### **Chardonnay, Robert Hall 2019**

Paso Robles, California **\$10**

pale yellow colour with brilliant green flecks. a concentrated and complex nose combining aromas of exotic fruits and white flowers. on the palate the wine is full-bodied, velvety and expresses aromas of citrus fruit before the supple and buttery finish.

### **Pinot Noir, Ken Wright Cellars 2017**

Willamette Valley, Oregon **\$14**

offers notes of darker blue and black fruits of cassis, blackberry and dried blueberry supported by firm acidity and moderate tannins

### **Malbec, Vina Cobos Felino 2019**

Mendoza, Argentina **\$13**

bright and deep purple color. aromas of black fruit reminiscent of fresh plum mixed with graphite notes. on the palate the wine is balanced and energetic, with sweet and round tannins and long finish.

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Two Mountain 2018**

Yakima Valley, Washington **\$13**

aromas of coffee, dark fruit and cedar combine with flavors of dark berry, currant, charred oak. velvety tannins lead to a lingering finish

## Champagne & Sparkling Wine

### **Prosecco, Lamberti**

Veneto, Italy 187 ml serves two **\$9**

palate is refreshing, and harmonious, with crisp fruit flavors and a clean finish

### **Prosecco, LaBella**

Veneto, Italy 750 ml **\$28**

it has high acidity and a fairly neutral palate. the aromatic profile is characterized by white peaches, with an occasional soapy note.

### **Brut N.V. Roederer Estate**

Mendocino, California **\$55**

a multi-vintage cuvee in the traditional Roederer style, known for its body, finesse and depth of flavor

### **Champagne, Dom Perignon**

Champagne, France **\$240**

the wine has a strong character and powerful presence - there is even something physical about it

## Whites by the Bottle

### **Pinot Gris, Lange WV 2019**

Willamette Valley, Oregon \$38

a tantalizing bouquet of cantaloupe, pineapple, pear, bergamot, pea vine, and lemongrass. crisp and lissome, with an acid-lit spine that gracefully unfolds across the palate, leaving in its wake eccentric rings of citrus fruit and limestone.

### **Ribolla Gialla, Luisa 2016**

Venice, Italy \$40

dry on the palate with flavors of pear, peach and citrus and a touch of minerality on the finish.

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Sineann 2015**

Marlborough, New Zealand \$34

intensity of fruit on the palate, mid-palate creaminess which is attributed to the remarkable fruit and lengthy finish

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Hill Family 2019**

Napa Valley, California \$39

bright and fresh, with flavors and aromas of peach, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit and balance notes of citrus and stone fruit. the mid-palate is full and the finish is lengthy and crisp.

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Honig, 2020**

Napa Valley, California \$35

flavors and aromas are reminiscent of peaches, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit with perfectly balanced notes of citrus and stone fruit. the fullness of the midpalate is complemented by a crisp, lengthy finish.

### **Sancerre Blanc, Hubert Brochard 2017**

Loire Valley, France \$61

classic expression of a sauvignon blanc from the appellation with aromas and flavors of citrus, fresh herbs, and elderflower. minerals and fruit linger on the finish.

### **Riesling, Forge Dry Classique 2017**

Fingers Lake, NY \$35

with the nose of anise and mango, along with the candied lemon and saline flavor, this leads to a super fresh, dry riesling

### **Viognier, Yalumba 2020**

Southeastern Australia \$30

white flowers and honeysuckle dominate the aromas with ginger and five spice to finish. the white flowers and ginger lead into a creamy mid-palate with a silky textural finish.

### **Chardonnay, Big Table Farm "The Wild Bee" 2017**

Willamette Valley, Oregon \$53

offers up lemon custard and stone fruit for a clean bright expression. it has a persistent white floral note that leads into warm toast and hazelnut. perfectly developed golden grapes, finish like a bite of perfectly ripe pear.

### **Chardonnay, Paul Hobbs "Crossbarn" 2019**

Sonoma County, California \$53

luminescent pastel gold in color, aromatic mélange of stone fruit with hints of lemon zest.

### **Rose, Domaine Lafage Nirafors 2020,**

France \$30

fruity with citrus hints of grapefruit, orange peel, strawberry and roses. fresh, rich and vibrant, notes of lemon and apricot flood the palate.

## White Wines of Distinction

### **Pinot Grigio, Alois Lageder "Porer" 2017**

Alto Adige, Italy \$50

very aromatic and opulent with uplifted varietal aromas paired with pronounced mineral notes and elegant oak spice.

### **Chardonnay, Rombauer 2017**

Napa Valley, California \$70

enticing aromas of vanilla, peach and mango are layered with apricots, creme brulee, butter and a slight minerality. the long, smooth finish is marked by mouthwatering acidity

### **Chardonnay, Les Noistiers Kistler 2018**

Sonoma County, California \$95

classic balance of layered, juicy fruit and mineral backbone. It is delicious wine, with white flowers and stone fruit aromatics leading to a full bodied, juicy core, loaded with flavors of peach, apricots, pineapple and pear. The finish goes a mile long.

## Reds by the Bottle

### **Pinot Noir, County Line 2017**

Sonoma County California \$53

medium body with raspberry & strawberry notes with subtle floral scents

### **Nebbiolo, La Spinetta 2016**

Piedmont, Italy \$62

is seductive upon entry with licorice, cherry and rose petal nuances. the tannins kick in towards the long, powerful finish

### **Grenache, Linne Calodo Stereotype 2018**

Paso Robles, California \$92

a velvet palate with hints of boysenberry jam. this wine is all California with a deep ruby color and a charismatic presence.

### **Merlot, Two Mountain 2016**

Yakima Valley, Washington \$35

bright vibrant Bing cherry, blackberry and coffee on the nose followed by ripe red fruits, hints of toffee and vanilla, and soft integrated tannins.

### **Merlot, Substance 2016**

Columbia Valley, WA \$60

medium to full-bodied and balanced, an ample spiced red and black fruits.

### **Malbec, Luca 2016**

Tunuyan, Argentina \$62

good depth and very lively acidity that leads to an incredibly long finish

### **Zinfandel, Turley Juvenile 2019**

Napa Valley, California \$40

dark flavors with notes of sweet cedar & baking spices. medium-weight wine, balanced with bright acidity, & a lingering finish.

### **Zinfandel, Buehler 2015**

Napa Valley, California \$47

aromas of a briar patch on a hot summer day carry over to the palate and are carried in a mouth-filling, deeply layered, juicy package.

### **CDR Red, E. Guigal 2017**

Rhone France \$35

intensely aromatic, with black fruits and spices with a long finish, with elegance and finesse accompanying the abundance of fruit and well-balanced tannins.

### **Bordeaux Blend, Chateau Greysac, Medoc Cru Bourgeois 2015**

Medoc, France \$48

deep ruby garnet with red berry flavors combined with notes of spice and green bell peppers.

### **Bordeaux Blend, Chappellet MTN Cuvee 2019**

Napa Valley California \$72

aromas of concentrated fruit and spice, with layers of red currant, cassis, cinnamon, vanilla and clove, as well as hints of earthy forest floor, wild sage and sweet toasty oak.

### **Syrah, Owen Roe "Ex Umbris" 2017**

Yakima Valley, Washington \$42

nose of candied sugarplum, fresh red raspberry swirl throughout. with juicy flavors of blackberry jam, bing cherry compote & cocoa nib

### **Syrah, St. Joseph, Francois de Tournon 2015**

Rhone, France \$75

nose of cassis and spices, smooth and voluptuous texture masking a good tannic structure, fine and silky

### **Shiraz, Tait The Wild Ride, 2018**

Australia \$40

rich cherry red color, with concentrated aromas of mulberry, spice, rosemary and earthiness with hints of vanilla that jump from the glass. the palate is rich showing ripe and rich fruit, great length and a velvety soft lingering finish.

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Kith & Kin 2018**

Napa Valley, California \$74

prepares the palate with aromas of cherry jubilee, coco-dusted red berries, and subtle hints of spice.

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, L'Ecole No 41 2016**

Columbia Valley, Washington \$55

shows layers of dark fruit, espresso, violet, and herbal notes, layers of blackberry and cassis mingle with dusty tannins through a persistent finish.

## Red Wines of Distinction

### **Pinot Noir, Bergstrom Gregory Ranch 2015**

Willamette Valley, Oregon **\$115**

peppery with a well-defined raspberry and cherry taste, with streaks of toast and graphite layers

### **Burgandy, Faiveley Gevrey Chambertin 2017**

Burgandy, France **\$99**

deep, clear ruby red hue, it reveals notes of black fruits and excellent strength and concentration. as with all Gevrey-Chambertin, it requires a few years of patience before reaching its full potential.

### **Barolo, Vietti Castiglione 2015**

Piemonte, Italy **\$96**

beautiful glowing ruby and fine earthy nose. succulent palate with a powerful tannic structure. really long and a little vibrant. firm, long red-fruit finish

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Shafer 1.5 2016**

Napa Valley, California **\$144**

blend of blackberry, black cherry, balsamic-infused strawberry, blueberry, cassis, herbs, and mocha.

### **Cabernet Chateau Montelena Napa 2018**

Napa Valley, California **\$125**

Fresh berries and dried cherries comingle with bergamot, lavender, mint, gunpowder, and sage without a single element dominating another.

### **Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de la Janesse 2015**

Rhone, France **\$95**

sensational notes of kirsch liqueur, black raspberries, crushed flowers, crushed rocks, and incense

### **Margaux, Chateau Palmer "Alter Ego" 2012**

Margaux, France **\$192**

with a ruby color, floral, cherry blossoms, earthy, fennel and spice notes lead to a sweet, cherry filled-wine with dusty tannins, supple textures and a fresh, spicy cassis finish
