Chardonnay, Balancing Act, Washington \$9

The yellow apple, melon and spice aromas are bright and inviting. The palate is fresh and clean, with broad, vibrant flavors playing nicely against a tart finish

Sauvignon Blanc Blend, Edgebaston,

Stellenbosch, South Africa **\$11**

This has the aroma of papaya, melon and litchi and is smooth and creamy on the palate with soft, tropical fruit notes of papaya, litchi and mango, ending with a fresh, long finish.

Riesling, Bex, Nahe, Germany \$9

Vibrant layers of luscious fruit are in perfect balance with zippy acidity and a layer of complex minerality throughout

Pinot Grigio, J Dusi, Paso Robles, California \$9

Extreme freshness and crispness while experiencing depth of aromas and fruit on the palate

Cabernet Sauvignon, Vigilance, California \$11

Tasting this medium-bodied wine reveals more of the same black cherry and vanilla wrapped up in a silky smooth texture with soft tannins. It ends with a dry grippy finish with good length

Pinot Noir, Carlton Cellars, Seven Devils,

Willamette Valley **\$13**

This is a tasty, good value effort with fresh strawberry and cherry fruit flavors. Its light suggestions of toast and cocoa point to some time in barrel, as does its pleasant whiff of east Asian spice.

Malbec, Rutini "Trumpeter", Mendoza, Argentina \$9

Excellent body, intense tannins, and flavors of cherry, blackberry, boysenberry and plum intermingled with hints of cardamom

Zinfandel, Klinker Brick, Lodi, California \$11

Berries and spice on the nose, dark, sweet fruit fills the palate with just a hint of black pepper

Whites by the Bottle

Sauvignon Blanc, Dog Point, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$40**
textural on the palate, with juicy acidity, minerality, and a refreshing lemon/lime infused finish

Sauvignon Blanc, Sineann, Marlborough, New Zealand **\$38**
intensity of fruit on the palate, mid-palate creaminess which is attributed to the remarkable fruit and lengthy finish

Pinot Blanc, Richard Böcking, Mosel, Germany **\$30**
fruit forward with a nice body, dry while still fresh and bright with a hint of exotic exuberance

Devon Riesling, Richard Bocking, Mosel, Germany **\$32**
great aromas of kiwi, green apple, white peach and lime. This balanced, fresh Riesling shines with notes of citrus and slate.

Vermentino, Costamolino, Argiolas, Sardinia **\$32**
shows a delightfully zesty acidity, which makes it the wine of choice for many dishes

Chenin Blanc, Viogner, Pine Ridge, California **\$30**
palate is crisp and mouth-watering, leading with luscious papaya, yellow pear and ruby grapefruit flavors

Pinot Gris, Elk Cove Winery, Willamette Valley, Oregon **\$35**
melon soft texture unfolds with Meyer lemon and peach preserve hinting at undertones of ginger spice, hibiscus and rhubarb

Chardonnay, Baileyana "Firepeak", Edna Valley, California **\$50**
flavors of crisp pear and red apple are seamlessly woven with notes of citrus, minerality, and a hint of vanilla

Chardonnay, Paul Hobbs, "CrossBarn" Sonoma Coast, CA **\$50**
luminescent pastel gold in color, aromatic mélange of stone fruit with hints of lemon zest.

Rose, Belleruche M. Chapoutier, Rhone France, **\$30**
This wine has aromas of red fruits, currant, raspberry and cherry. On the palate, the freshness is well-balanced and round.

Luisa Ribolla Gialla, Venice, Italy **\$40**
dry on the palate with flavors of pear, peach and citrus and a touch of minerality on the finish.

Inama Vin Soave, Italy **\$30**
pleasant on the palate with a back taste of sweet almond.

White Wines of Distinction

Chardonnay, Sea Smoke Cellars "Streamside"
Santa Rita Hills, California **\$110**
aromas of lemon curd, white peach, cut stone and jasmine, complemented by a mid-palate and refreshing cool climate acidity

Sauvignon Blanc, Honig Rutherford, Napa Valley, CA **\$48**
summer fruit aromas and flavors are highlighted by lemon bar, vanilla and toasty oak.

Pinot Grigio, Alois Lageder "Porer" **\$50**
very aromatic and opulent with uplifted varietal aromas paired with pronounced mineral notes and elegant oak spice.

Reds by the Bottle

Pinot Noir, Point North, Oregon \$35

On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied with dark fruit flavors, raspberries and earthy spice notes

Pinot Noir, Trisaetum, Willamette Valley Oregon \$47

Light and fruity with high minerality on the back. Great aromas with a slight acidity.

Grenache, Shatter, France \$40

The entry is vibrant and powerful which leads to luscious flavors of wild strawberry that perfectly rounds out the mid-palate

Grenache, Lafage, Rhone, France \$30

Palate is rich, round, concentrated, with silky tannins with powerful notes of blackberry, cassis, raspberry and blueberry

Carmenere, Inama, Veneto, Italy \$40

Elegant front-palate with fresh acidity, firm, integrated tannins and length

Merlot, Two Mountain, Yakima Valley, Washington \$35

Aromas of rich toasted barrel, bright vibrant Bing cherry, blackberry and coffee on the nose followed by inviting flavors of ripe red fruits, hints of toffee and vanilla, and soft integrated tannins.

Merlot, Bookwalter, Foreshadow,

Colombia Valley, Washington \$68

A sweet, lush softness, expands through the mid-palate, and stays on course displaying a variety of red and blue fruits.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Bookwalter, Foreshadow,

Colombia Valley, Washington \$80

Both aromatically and on the palate, the wine displays a symphony of bright red fruits led by cherries and raspberries

Cabernet Sauvignon, Justin Vineyards,

Paso Robles, California \$50

Medium-plus body with dark fruit of cassis and black cherry on the entry

Cabernet Sauvignon, Luke, Wahluke Slope, Washington \$45

A balanced and full-bodied cabernet with generous tannin structure, opulent flavors of rich fruit, spice and smoke-revealing itself with a long lingering finish.

Cabernet Franc Lang & Reed, Napa Valley California \$50

Hints of raspberry and dark cherry with a mouth watering level of acidity with a soft finish

Malbec, Luigi Bosca, Argentina \$40

distinct aromas of ripe red fruits, spices and black pepper

Malbec, Luca, Tunuyan, Argentina \$60

Good depth and very lively acidity that leads to an incredibly long finish

Zinfandel, Renwood, Dry Creek, California \$35

Dusty tannins and firm structure frame with elements of ollaliberry, dark cherry, black pepper, sage and a chocolate finish

Zinfandel, Beran, California \$45

Ruby red with a dark core. Berry flavors with notes of sweet cedar & baking spices. Opulent & satisfying, this medium-weight wine is balanced with bright acidity, integrated tannins & a lingering finish.

Syrah, Amavi Cellars, Walla Walla, Washington \$52

Flavors of raspberry, black currant, olive tapenade with a mouthful that shows elegant acidity, complex tannins and a lengthy finish

Syrah, Owen Roe, Yakima Valley, Washington \$42

mouthwatering aromas of candied sugarplum, fresh red raspberry swirl throughout. The slight slate & vanilla notes are interlaced with juicy flavors of blackberry jam, bing cherry compote & subtle hints of cocoa nib

Zisola, Nero D Avola, Italy \$52

rich flavors of blackberry and dark cherry, accented by notes of violet, pepper and exotic spices

Nebbiolo Funsu, Cascina ca' Rossa Langhe, Italy \$40

complex and fruity with delicate notes of rose and violet. well-structured, fat, robust, and slightly tannic.

Strength, intensity and elegance with delicate tannins which express its fullness

Syrah/Grenache Blend Mas Donis Capcanes, Spain \$30

wild red and black berry flavors, cherry, spices and herbs; well integrated elegant smooth vanilla oaky toasty notes

Vietti Barolo Castiglione, Italy \$85

beautiful glowing ruby and fine earthy nose. succulent palate with a powerful tannic structure. really long and a little vibrant. firm, long red-fruit finish

Ladera, Cabernet Sauvignon, Howell Mountain Reserve

Napa Valley, California **\$155**

gorgeous aromas of ripe blackberries and black cherries with notes of fresh mint, cocoa, vanilla and nutmeg

Rubicon Estate 2008, California \$250

blackberry and cherry pie filling flavors, and the oak appliqué is perfect

Shaffer Cabernet One point Five, California \$140

blend of blackberry, black cherry, balsamic-infused strawberry, blueberry, cassis, herbs, and mocha.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinq Cepages Chateau St. Jean,

Sonoma, California **\$125**

juicy palate with flavors of blueberry, cherry and blackberry. nuanced flavors of espresso and a distinct mocha component

Champagne & Sparkling Wine / Dessert Wines

Prosecco, LaBella, Veneto, Italy 750 ml \$28

it has high acidity and a fairly neutral palate. the aromatic profile is characterized by white peaches, with an occasional soapy note.

Prosecco, Lamberti, Veneto, Italy 187 ml serves two \$8

palate is refreshing, and harmonious, with crisp fruit flavors and a clean finish

Prosecco, Rustico, Valdobbiadene, Italy \$45

gorgeously elegant, fresh, lively fruit, notes of bread dough and citrus, and persistent effervescence

Brut N.V. Roederer Estate, Mendocino, California \$60

a multi-vintage cuvee in the traditional Roederer style, known for its body, finesse and depth of flavor

Champagne, Dom Perignon, Champagne, France \$220

the wine has a strong character and powerful presence – there is even something physical about it

Champagne N.V., Perrier-Jouet, Champagne, France \$98

fresh and lively with spiraling bubbles, delicate bouquet, and subtle complex flavors

Muscat de Rivesaltes, Chateau de Caladroy, France \$9.00 / glass

floral notes of orange blossom and peach. the creaminess and freshness balance perfectly for the pleasure of the taste buds. the elegant finish reveals notes of crunch Muscat and Sicilian lemon.

Saracco Moscato D'Asti, Italy \$22

intense, elegant and lingering. The sweet sensations are well balanced with a pleasant acidity and fruity aromas typical of Muscat grapes.
